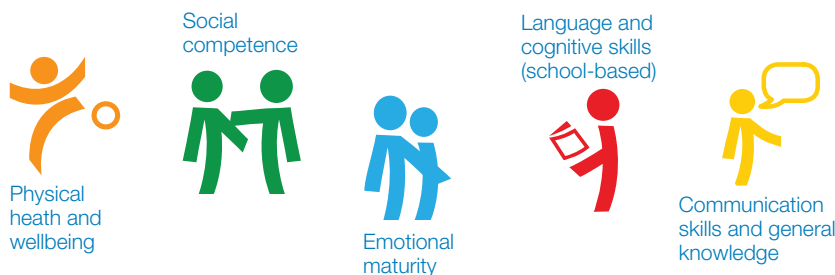


## Community Service Organisations

The AEDC is a starting point for identifying the needs of children in your community.

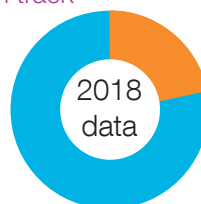


Use the AEDC results to start a conversation with other service providers in your area.
