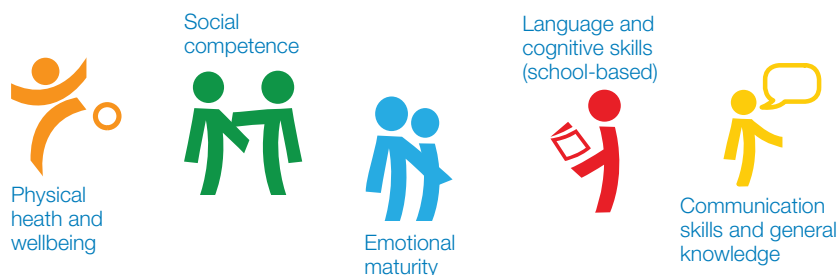


Local Government
